CLASSROOM ACTIVITIES

Eighteen Central Ohio school districts use the highly acclaimed Kids Voting curriculum activities to engage students (K-12) while helping teachers meet Ohio academic standards.

ELECTION SIMULATION

Students learn how to research information on candidates and issues, talk with parents and others about elections and voting, and take part in a simulated election each year.

YOUTH AT THE BOOTH

Since 2006, this award-winning program has given more than 5,900 high school seniors the chance to work as precinct officials at the polls for the Franklin County Board of Elections. Students are recruited and trained by Kids Voting.

YOUTH SUMMIT

In the past nine years, more than 1,300 high school students have attended a unique Kids Voting event at the Ohio Statehouse. Activities range from town hall meetings to creating public service announcements encouraging teens to register and vote.

Outcomes show that Kids Voting works.

Students discuss issues with their peers and family, and they are much more likely to vote when they turn 18.
